

## VENDOR AGREEMENT

### BOOTH LOCATIONS

Vendor booths are located in the lobby of the show arena providing high traffic flow and excellent visibility. The vendor area is air conditioned and well lit.

### EXHIBITION HOURS

Vendors may arrive onsite Friday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> to set-up. Exhibition hours are Saturday, September 4<sup>th</sup>, 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. CT.

### ELECTRICITY

30 amp electrical service may be purchased for \$35

### CARE OF BUILDING EQUIPMENT

Exhibitors or their agents shall not injure, deface the walls of the building. Exhibitors are forbidden to drive tacks, nails, or screws into the walls or woodwork. When such damage appears, the exhibitor is liable to the owner of the property so damaged.

### ENFORCEMENT

The Exhibitor agrees to comply strictly with the applicable terms and conditions contained in this agreement. The Exhibit Management reserves the right to restrict exhibits which because of noise, method of operation, materials, or any other reason become objectionable, and also to prohibit or evict any exhibit which in the opinion of Exhibit Management may detract from the general character of the exhibit as a whole. This reservation includes persons, things, conduct, printed matter, or anything of a character which the Exhibit Management determines is objectionable to the exhibit or does not conform to the standard of the Exposition. In the event of such restriction or eviction, the Exhibit Management is not liable for any refund or other exhibit expenses.

### LIABILITY

The Exhibit Management, Sponsor, Landlord and Exhibitor's Service, and their officers and staff members disclaim all liability for damages or losses to any Exhibitor caused by fire, water, flood, windstorm, utility failures, rodents, acts of vandalism, insurrection, civil disorder, strikes, criminal acts, or theft. Exhibit Management will not be responsible for any failure of electric or other services. Exhibitors wishing to insure their goods must do so at their own expense. And further, the Exhibitor shall at all times protect, indemnify, save and keep harmless the Exhibit Management, Sponsor, Landlord, and the Exhibitor's Service against any and all loss, cost, damage, liability or expenses arising from or out of or by reason of any accident or other occurrence to anyone, including the Exhibit or its agents, employees and invitees, which arises from or out of by reason of said Exhibitor's occupancy and use of the Exhibition premises or a part thereof.

### EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES

In the unforeseeable occurrence that cancellation or alteration of The Festival becomes necessary due to Acts of God or extenuating circumstances beyond our control, The Pyramid Society reserves the right to reimburse exhibitors' fees commensurate with non-refundable production expenses incurred to date.

### INTERPRETATION AND AMENDMENTS

Exhibit Management shall have the full power to interpret and enforce all rules contained herein, and the power to make amendments thereto, and to enact such further rules and regulations as shall be considered necessary for the proper conduct of the Exhibition.
